### Nestlings 3rd Birthday...

Nestlings celebrated its 3rd Birthday on February 9th. Three years ago a conversation started the idea and ball rolling toward founding Nestlings. It is truly amazing to think of all that has happened in just a few years.

Nestlings distributed it's 100,000th diaper in the fall of 2013.

Nestlings has distributed over 50,000 diapers each year for the past two years. With the goal for 2014 being to distribute 75,000 diapers or more into the low income community toward



fighting diaper need. Thousands of families with babies and children have been helped thanks to the diapers provided by Nestlings and **You** the community.

#### Big Happenings...

Exciting and wonderful opportunities came Nestlings way in February this year. Nestlings received a donation of 50,000 diapers from a partnership between Meijer, Huggies and The National Diaper Bank.

Next, Nestlings was recognized for its work by the Women Who Care Group and gifted with their first quarter grant gift thanks to Marcia Davis who presented Nestlings organization to the group. Women Who Care



is a great group of women who meet 4 times a year and commit to donating \$100. each per quarter to a non-profit organization in our community that the group

chooses. This group of women proves that together you can make a small commitment while still making big impact on the organizations that work helping others in our community.



Nestlings was then named one of 8 finalist in the Wood TV8 Connecting with Community Award. What an honor it was to be named along side of all the other wonderful organizations doing great works in West Michigan. Nestlings received a 2 minute video that played multiple times on Wood TV8 for one week. The news story by Eva Aguirre Cooper can be seen on our website at nestlings.org. Nestlings did not win the

award but truly felt like it did just being part of the process with the other non-profits selected.

The Holland Junior Welfare League also recognized Nestlings with a 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive year grant gift which allowed for the purchase of over 2,000 diapers in the most needed and distributed sizes of 4, 5 and 6. The diapers were re-packaged



by great volunteers, then sent back out the door to over 18 partner agencies and will help hundreds of families in need.

## Nestlings Diaper Days and Community Baby Shower...



In June, Nestlings hosted a 4 day free community event to bring awareness to the issue of Diaper Need.

Nestlings host regularly scheduled Diaper Wrapping and



Agency Pick Up Days. They are held on the 2nd Friday of every month between 1pm-3pm and on the 3rd Monday of every month between 9:30am -11:30am.



Partner agencies can pick up diaper orders during these times if the order has been sent in 3 days prior. If you would like to volunteer to help re-package diapers feel free to also stop in during the same times and you will be put to work.

Nestlings host groups who would like to re-wrap diapers as a team building activity, community give back or just for fun. Mead Johnson, Kohls, Walgreens, Girls on the Run, The Red Hat Ladies, Women's Service Day and Meijer are some of the great groups that have helped re-package diapers that are distributed for the babies.
